



## Waste Management Plan

CSM provides products to site as a completed unit, where assembly is required only parts required to assemble the product are taken to site.

No packaging material is used to deliver cabinets and shelving to site in the Sydney Metro Area, therefore, no packaging waste needs to be disposed of. For deliveries outside the Sydney Metro area shelving is packaged for protection, therefore the waste needs to be disposed of accordingly.

### Objectives

- Keep the site tidy. Use the bins on site
- Use recycling bins if provided
- Record waste that leaves the site on the Waste Register
- Adhere to management strategies

Waste Stream	Example of Waste type	Classification	Management Strategy
Office Waste	Food	Solid waste	Dispose of in appropriate bins provided by the site management. Recycling for plastics and aluminium. Compost bins for food wastes. Refuse for all other components unable to be recycled.
Packaging	Timber Pallets, steel strapping, cardboard	Inert waste	Timber Pallets returned to CSM for reuse. Steel Strapping returned to CSM for recycling Cardboard returned to CSM for reuse.
Installation Activities	Swarf	Inert waste	Collect and dispose of in appropriate bin (for aluminium recycling) provided by site management.
